

2020 RAIN CITY FLYERS SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Applications are being accepted for the 2020 Rain City Flyers scholarship. The scholarship is funded by the generous donations of RCF families and friends. To date we have awarded \$11,900 in scholarship support. Additional details about the scholarship and past recipients can be accessed at <http://raincityflyers.com/scholarship.html>

The 2020 scholarship(s) will be awarded to an applicant (or applicants if the scholarship committee determines appropriate) who most embodies the purposes for which the scholarship was established. The applicant should be a high school senior, graduating in 2020, who plans to continue their education. The scholarship recipient must have participated in the Rain City Flyers program at some time and demonstrated a commitment to working to achieve their best, both as an individual and as a member of the team. In addition, the recipient will be a recognized role model of an exemplary and responsible athlete/citizen.

The amount expected to be awarded for scholarships in 2020 is \$2,500, to possibly be increased depending on available funds. In the discretion of the scholarship committee the scholarship may be split between multiple applicants. If no suitable graduating high school seniors apply, consideration may be given to current college students otherwise meeting the scholarship criteria.

To apply for the scholarship, applicants should submit:

- An application letter providing name and contact information; details of their RCF participation; significant accomplishments or recognition beyond RCF for academic, artistic, athletic and/or community activities; post high school plans, including athletic, if any; and how the scholarship will help further their educational goals.
- An essay of not more than two pages that tells the applicant's Rain City story. The Scholarship Committee is interested in what participation in Rain City Flyers meant to the applicant, how it contributed to the applicant's scholastic and extracurricular experiences, and how it might support future educational and life goals.
